#### **Introduction**

With its almost 53 million inhabitants, the East African country of Kenya is still one of the 50 poorest countries in the world. In terms of its economic development, it is above the average of the other sub-Saharan countries and is considered a growth country, a lower middle-income country and an important transit country (source: GTAI). Kenya faces major challenges in meeting the needs of its growing population with food, also against the backdrop of high weather-related dependencies on rainfall and the implementation of irrigation projects. The main potential for German agricultural machinery manufacturers is seen in larger agricultural enterprises, which are predominantly private companies and cooperatives.

In view of the shortage of capital in the wake of the Corona pandemic, the seminar will also focus on creative financing solutions for German manufacturers as an important building block for maintaining dialogue with potential customers in the country.

The participants should be enabled to assess the marketing situation and export opportunities against the background of the current economic situation.
